

Wash- and Careguide - Dogs

HOT SPOT:

- Wash or pat the Hot Spot daily
- Let the area dry by air
- Use KovaLine wipes or use KovaLine care solution at a ratio of 1:10 with a disposable foam cloth

WOUNDS AND ABRASIONS:

- Wash the intended area daily
- It's best to apply immediately after the injury as soon as the bleeding has stopped
- Let the area dry by air
- Use KovaLine wipes or use KovaLine care solution at a ratio of 1:10 with a disposable foam cloth

AROUND THE EYES AND EARS:

- Wash the intended area daily
- Keep the solution away from direct contact with the surface of the eyes
- Use the solution on the outer of the ear, use the corner edge of a wipe or a disposable foam cloth with your index finger for better control.

Smelly or fatty skin, intermediate stage of demodex:

DAY 1:

- Lightly wet the dog
- Wash the dog directly without using the care solution
- If the soap doesn't foam/lather repeat the procedure
- Rinse with water
- Dry the dogs fur

DAY 2:

- Lightly wet the dog
- Wash the dog with the 1:10 care solution, have a bowl with the solution on hand
- Do not rinse
- Pat excess care solution with the use of a towel

CARING FOR THE SKINFOLDS ON PUGS, BULLDOG, MASTIFF, SHAR-PEI ETC.

- Wash or wipe the inside of the skinfolds of the dogs skin
- After a few minutes dry with paper towels or cloth
- Keep the solution away from direct contact with the surface of the eyes
- Use KovaLine wipes or use KovaLine care solution at a ratio of 1:10 with a disposable foam cloth

KOVALINE OIL/WAX OINTMENT:

- Apply the KovaLine Oil/Wax ointment onto the clean dry area
- Suitable for dry and chapped noses
- Wipe the area around the muzzle
- Dry paws and general paw care
- Dry ear edges and long ears
- Oil/Wax ointment is also suitable as step two after the use of KovaLine KL CareSoap and for the care of difficult wounds.

The procedure is continued daily as needed until the issue is resolved. It is important to continue the treatment until the area is 100% healed as a possible infection can reoccur if treatment is stopped too early. It is advisable to contact your veterinarian if in doubt

SUPPORT/AID TREATMENT:

KovaLine is a non-medical product who belongs in the category of support/aid treatment. This means that support for controlled treatment with drugs, adjusting the environment or vaccination

SUPPORT/AID TREATMENT INVOLVES:

- Optimal nutrition (Omega-3 and Omega-6)
- Wash and control of microorganisms on the skin
- Cleaning of the ear
- Paw care
- Antibiotics (when necessary)
- Fungicide (when necessary)

It is important to identify the primary cause of the disorder in the dog. A very important factor that needs to be focused on is optimal nutrition, the intake of high-quality Omega-3, Omega-6, and fatty acids play crucial role in maintaining a healthy skin on dogs.
